#### What is a Life Group?

**Life Groups** are small, Christ-centered gatherings of people who choose to do life together for a season. These groups create space for meaningful connection, spiritual growth, serving and giving members the opportunity to grow in the **Five Marks of a Disciple:** 

- Believe in Jesus
- Invest in the Kingdom
- Choose Community
- Serve the Cause
- Live as an Ambassador

#### What is the Leadership Pathway?

The Leadership Pathway is our intentional process by which the church identifies and involves those whom God has gifted and called to lead; invests in their spiritual growth and leadership skills through biblical training, development, and care; and invites them to step into roles of service for the purpose of building up of His Kingdom through the Five Marks of a Disciple while influencing others to do the same.

#### One on Ones's (Shepherd and Care)

Coaches and staff (Once a month connection)

- -Meet together twice a year covering personal walk with Christ, how the group is growing in the five marks, walk through any group challenges or pastoral follow ups, and update the current roster.
- -Attend the group once per year
- -Connect at church
- Use emails and texts to check in
